DID NOT FINISH (DNF). Any driver that takes the start will be given points from the position as stated in the race result. Exceptions to this will be if a driver has been disqualified after receiving a black flag. No driver is allowed to work on their kart on the circuit, not even to replace a chain. Any driver who continues to race after any repairs have taken place on the circuit will be black flagged.

NO BONUS POINTS

Only Club members will score championship points.

DROPPED POINTS. At the end of the 2020 season, two dropped rounds from the overall points i.e. a lowest scoring attended round and a non-attendance (ONLY ONE) round - otherwise 2 x lowest scoring attended rounds.

DISQUALIFICATION FROM A MEETING CANNOT BE USED AS A DROPPED ROUND

EQUAL POINTS. At least 5 rounds in any one year must be completed to enable a driver to become eligible to win a championship trophy. In the instance of a driver completing 4 rounds or less, the question of eligibility will be at the discretion of RLK Ltd. In the event of a tie for any of the final Championship positions at the end of the season, the advantage will go to the driver with the highest number of race wins. If these are equal, the decision will be made on the driver that has accomplished the highest scores in the most rounds. If there is still a tie, the driver with the highest score in the last scoring round will get the final decision.

TROPHIES: All classes are awarded a minimum of $1^{st} - 3^{rd}$ place providing the class has a minimum of 3 drivers competing.

TROPHIES REFERENCE LARGE GRIDS

When a class is divided into an A and B group then TROPHIES ARE ONLY AWARDED TO THE A GROUP from both final race results

END OF YEAR FINAL PRESENTATION will be held directly after the first round of the following championship year; the trophies will be awarded to drivers which have competed in at least 6 rounds throughout the year. Each class requires a minimum of 3 competitors per class to be included into the trophy awards presentation. **Reference HR29 rules**
